State of the art today

- NGI is the federal mapping agency
 - Public service with own legal status
 - Partly financed by federal government
 - Supervised by minister of Defence
- NGI provides NSDI data
 - Core framework topo-data
 - Administrative data
 - Toponyms
 - Orthophoto's

- Budget 2011 :
 - IN: 17.873 k€
 - subsidy: 13.009 k€
 - OUT: 18.413 k€
- Budget 2012 :
 - IN: 20.240 k€
 - subsidy: 13.350 k€, extra INSPIRE 2.980 k€
 - OUT: 22.119 k€
 - investments: 1.967 k€

Some figures

- Staff (1/12/2010):
 - 247 persons (192 civil servants, 55 state employees)
 - Total cost: 14.446 k€
- Staff
(budget + staff deployment plan 2010/11):
 - 253 persons (193 c.s., 60 s.e.)
 - Total cost: 15.485 k€
